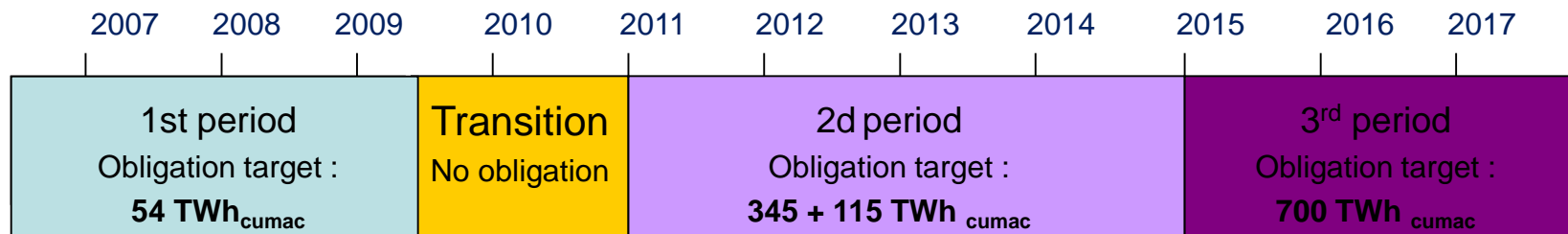


ENSPOL, NEVER-ENDING SCHOOL: INSIGHTS FROM POLICY EVALUATIONS AND CROSS-COUNTRY EXCHANGE



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- ❑ Since 2006 – 10 year anniversary!
- ❑ Obligation on energy suppliers + automotive fuel distributors
- ❑ To trigger final energy savings
- ❑ Mainly through standard measures with deemed saving calculations (over 90% of the obligation)
- ❑ Mainly on the building sector (60% residential, 20% tertiary)



- To communicate on the lessons learnt from the French EEO
- To learn about longtime existing EEOs but also about new EEOs and planned ones
- To question our current scheme and get valuable feedbacks from all over Europe (and the world!) to prepare for our next obligation period (2018-2020)

ENSPOLE reports, a wealth of information on article 7 implementation, allowing us:

- ⇒ To look at our scheme through a different grid
- ⇒ To learn about all existing and planned schemes
- ⇒ To look for similarities and differences compared to our scheme in terms of set up and evolution
- ⇒ To start identifying good practices that we could “import”

ENSPOOL workshops and observatories gave us the chance:

- ❑ To meet with national and European stakeholders and discuss

- ❑ Establish bilateral relationships with our counterparts in other MS
 - ⇒ *People doing the same job, facing the same challenges, try to answer the same questions... on additionality, monitoring and verifications, cost-efficiency but in very practical ways*
 - ⇒ *sometimes at different times,*
 - ⇒ *plenty to learn from each other!*

Following these meetings,

⇒ Close cooperation with several MS (IT, UK, LUX...)

⇒ *Confcall & Bilateral meetings*

⇒ *On very specialized matters (ie: fuel poverty alleviation in the UK EEO)*

⇒ *Involving different stakeholders: energy agencies, ministries, obligated parties representatives, energy regulators...*

⇒ Keep open lines of communication and look for further knowledge sharing opportunities in future

⇒ Looking forward to opening new lines of communication with other national and European stakeholders
